PRESENTATION SUMMARY

Kristina Verner began by giving a presentation that included an introduction to Waterfront Toronto as the catalyst and steward of waterfront revitalization and gave a highlight of WT's public policy objectives. She talked about WT's vision for Quayside, and described the Request for Proposal (RFP) process through which Sidewalk Labs was selected as its Innovation and Funding Partner. She described the project's core principles and gave an outline of the project schedule before introducing Jesse Shapins of Sidewalk Labs.

Jesse began by talking about the Doblin research study on community spaces before focusing on the current planning around public realm for Quayside. He gave detailed descriptions of the four key aspects of the public realm that SWL is exploring: streets, outdoor comfort, ground floor animation, and interactions with water.

The presentation took approximately 30 minutes and attendees were given the opportunity to ask questions following the presentation. No questions were asked.
